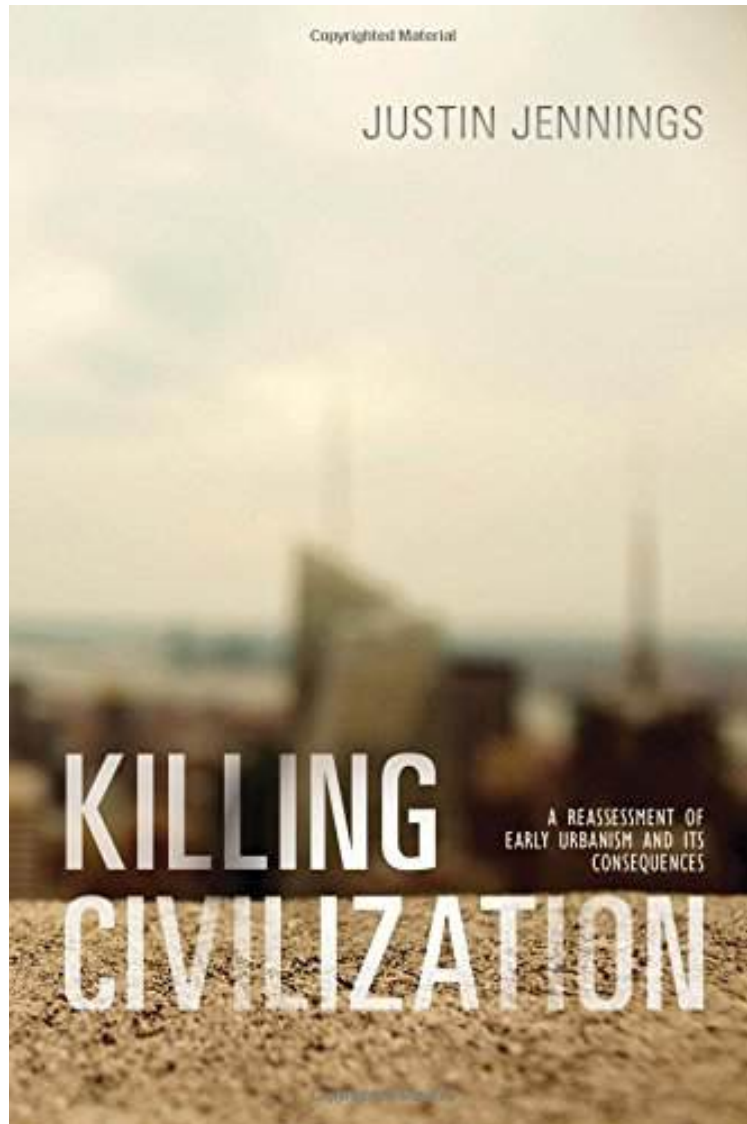

The author argues that a "civilization bias" shapes academic explanations of urbanization, colonization, state formation, and cultural horizons. Earlier theorists have criticized the concept, but according to Jennings, the critics remain beholden to it as a way of making sense of a dizzying landscape of cultural variability. For many archaeologists, urbanism is strongly linked to a series of other processes: state formation, social stratification, craft specialization, colonisation, and regional cultures, conveniently bundled as the concept of civilisation.
